Proposed Tax Rates, Valuations and Estimated Revenues for the 2024-2025 School Year

Dr. Steggall reviewed the Operating Levy recommendation of \$3.8211 and the Debt service recommendation at \$1.00 for a total of \$4.8211 for 24/25.
