Superintendent's Report

Building Updates

Dr. Burns gave an update for the high school that included EOCs, attendance at 93.09%, RTI and real world learning,

Mrs. Kriley reported attendance for the middle school for the first two quarters was 94.14% and 94% which is an increase over last year. Current enrollment is at 205 with 19 new students enrolled. Mrs. Kriley reviewed growth in various areas of learning.

Dr. Turner stated there are 298 students and 95.25% for attendance at Ellis. She stated that 32 families at Thanksgiving and 37 families for the holiday break had meals provided. Dr. Turner stated that there are 47 students participating in the backpack program which is up from 34.. She stated that the PAT program had gone from 82 to 110 this year. Dr. Turner reviewed various activities Stuco was involved in. She reviewed how data is being used at Ellis.

#### Strategic Plan Updates - Semester 1 recap

Dr. Steggall gave an overview of the CSIP. She reviewed the attendance which is currently 87.1% for 24/25 and reviewed the prior 3 years. Dr. Steggall also stated that enrollment is 657 for 24/25 and reviewed the prior 2 years history. She then reviewed APR, PD, and that advanced degrees have gone from 41 to 46 staff. Dr. Steggall reviewed data for staff recognition and appreciation through data from Motivosity. She stated that annual surveys go out in February to staff, parents and students.

#### Financial Report

Dr. Steggall reviewed November 2024 revenues and expenses as well as balances in Fund 1 and Fund 4.
