VI. Public Comment - The Mayor addressed recent statements circulating on social media, clarifying that the City did not remove the "No Parking" signs along Oak Street. The Mayor further noted that during home events, Plattsburg Police will be present to assist with directing parking and to help ensure safe passage for both event attendees and community members traveling through the area.

VII. Old Business - Dr. Steggall reported that the 2026 Bond issue was approved by voters. Veregy provided a brief overview of the project scope and prior discussions leading up to this point, noting that upon contract approval, work could begin with a target completion date of August 2027.

- A. Building & Department Updates (CSIP Goals)
 - 1. Dr. Burns presented an update on Plattsburg High School, including End-of-Course (EOC) data, progress monitoring of students throughout the year, and strong attendance trends.
 - 2. Mrs. Kriley presented an update on Clinton County Middle School, reviewing NWEA data from the beginning of the year to the present and noting continued strong attendance.

3. Dr. Turner presented an update on Ellis Elementary, including IXL data demonstrating student growth throughout the school year, along with strong attendance trends.
 4. Dr. Clark provided an update on the Special Education Department, including student services, evaluations, and programming.
 5. Mr. Adkins presented an update on Athletics and Activities, including recognition of student scholarship recipients, recent district events, and program updates. He noted that the District hosted five district tournaments, provided an update regarding SB 863, and shared plans for a touchscreen Wall of Fame with a new design anticipated in 2026.
 6. Mr. Knoche presented an update on the Technology Department, including operations and ongoing projects.
 7. Dr. Steggall presented a district update, including student and staff attendance trends, noting overall strong attendance throughout the school year. She also shared an overview of staff recognition efforts through the District's Motivosity program and highlighted upcoming Staff Appreciation Week.
