A. Finance Update - Dr. Steggall provided a financial update for April. Revenue for all funds totaled \$532,650.53, and expenses for all funds totaled \$800,978.70. Fund 1 ending balance was reported at \$5,107,076.99, and Fund 4 ending balance was reported at \$595,679.32.

B. Legislative Update - Dr. Steggall provided a legislative update regarding the state budget, school funding, and pending legislation affecting school districts. Discussion included the foundation formula, state adequacy target projections, open enrollment proposals, accountability legislation, school choice expansion, and property tax and income tax reform.


C. Summer School - Dr. Steggall reported that summer school will run June 2 through June 26, Tuesday through Friday, from 8:00 a.m. to 3:45 p.m. Approximately 160 students are enrolled.
